Interpretation and Definitions

Interpretation

The words of which the initial letter is capitalized have meanings defined under the following conditions. The following definitions shall have the same meaning regardless of whether they appear in singular or in plural.

Definitions

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

- "Personal Information" is any information that relates to an identified or identifiable individual.
- "Service" refers to service provided by us such as emergency care, teeth whitening, preventative care, orthodontics, pediatric dentistry, implants, bridges, crowns, cosmetic dentistry, dentures, digital x-rays, dental health and root canals and periodontal treatments
- "You" means the individual accessing or using the Service, or the company, or other legal entity on behalf of which such individual or using the Service, as applicable

Collecting and Using your Personal Information

Types of information collected

While using our service we might ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify You. Personally identifiable information may include, but not limited to:

- Email address
- First and last name
- Address, State, Province, Postal code, City
- Contact number
- Usage data

Limiting Collection, Use and Disclosure

The company may use personal information for the following purposes:
